RANGE SAFETY RULES

(Obj/Handout #1.1.13)

- 1. All firearms are to be treated as if they are always loaded.
- 2. Never let the muzzle of the firearm cover anything that you are not willing to destroy.
- 3. Be sure of your target and what is beyond it.
- 4. Keep your finger off of the trigger until the sights are aligned on the target and you have made the decision to fire.

RANGE RULES

- Do not load, unload or handle you weapon unless you are on the firing line, no one else is down range from you and you have the permission of the instructor.
- 2. When on the firing line, all muzzles will be pointed safely down range at all times.
- 3. If you have a problem with your weapon that you cannot fix, keep your weapon pointed safely down range, raise your hand and wait for an instructor to come to you.
- 4. There will be a safety area where you can work on or clean your weapon. No ammunition will be in the safety area.
- 5. The instructor will have the final say on any issue involving safety on the range.
