

RANGE SAFETY RULES

(Obj/Handout #1.1.13)

1. All firearms are to be treated as if they are always loaded.
2. Never let the muzzle of the firearm cover anything that you are not willing to destroy.
3. Be sure of your target and what is beyond it.
4. Keep your finger off of the trigger until the sights are aligned on the target and you have made the decision to fire.

RANGE RULES

1. Do not load, unload or handle you weapon unless you are on the firing line, no one else is down range from you and you have the permission of the instructor.
2. When on the firing line, all muzzles will be pointed safely down range at all times.
3. If you have a problem with your weapon that you cannot fix, keep your weapon pointed safely down range, raise your hand and wait for an instructor to come to you.
4. There will be a safety area where you can work on or clean your weapon. No ammunition will be in the safety area.
5. The instructor will have the final say on any issue involving safety on the range.
