



SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY
TROOPERS LODGE #41 SCHOLARSHIP / LINE OF DUTY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

A child of an active member, or a dependent member of his/her household under the age of 25 years (as of July 1, 2023) and the sponsor member has been in good standing for at least one (1) year, (recently graduated cadets of less than one year are exempt).

The scholarship candidate must be enrolled in an accredited college or university and be a full-time student (12 credit hours or more per semester) in an undergraduate capacity. Full-time nurses training and similar courses will be accepted.

Person(s) who would **NOT BE ELIGIBLE:**

1. Member.
2. Member's spouse.
3. **Previous recipients of Troopers Lodge #41 Scholarship (in part or full) are only eligible to apply for Line of Duty Memorial scholarship.**

Previous recipients of Brian McMillen Scholarship (in part or full) are only eligible to apply for Troopers Lodge #41 scholarships.
Brian McMillen Scholarship is now called Line of Duty Memorial Scholarship

4. Part-time trade or industrial school where no tuition is paid and/or the student is paid by the institution while in student status.
5. Part-time students (less than 12 hours per semester).

Eligibility will be predicated upon the Lodge enrollment roster as of July 1st of the current year. No transfer will be made arbitrarily for a period of twelve (12) months prior to the scholarship drawing (or July 1st of current year), for purposes of benefiting in the scholarship program.

Deadline for Applications is September 8, 2023

Applicants shall compete only in one Troop/District.

Scholarship winners will be notified by **E-MAIL**; a list of winners will be posted online on the Troopers Lodge #41 website.

Winners will have 30 days upon announcement to accept the scholarship prize. Enrollment verification must be submitted to the Troopers Lodge #41 office by December 31, 2023 or the scholarship will not be awarded.
